FIDE Rated: 1 hour; Under 150, Under 100: 30 minutes

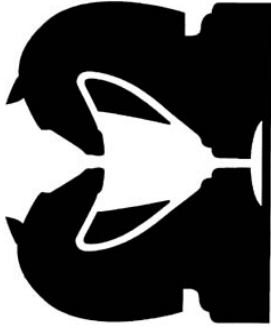
**Late Fee** A fee of £5 is payable for any entry postmarked after Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> December. Any entry received on the day of entry will be subject to a late fee of £10.

Entries on the day and players who have not paid in advance. All entry fees are due in full before the start of the second round of the first day.

**Players who compete in the Northwick Park Congress** may deduct an extra £3 from their entry to the London Christmas Congress if the entry is postmarked before Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> December. Players entering after this date can ignore the late fee if they enter in advance. Players who enter on the day will still pay the £10 late fee.

Members of the ECF can deduct £2 from their entry.

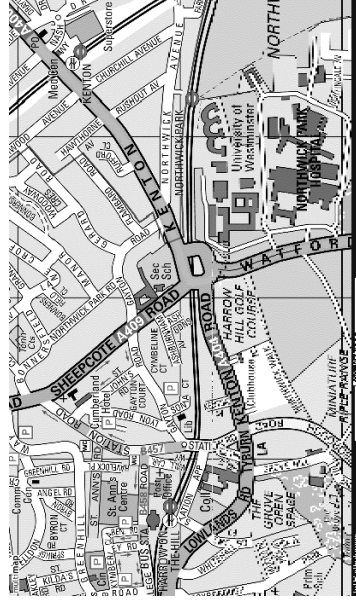

## Getting there



The venue is easy to reach by all forms of transport

### Coming by Underground

The venue is a four minutes walk from Northwick Park Station on the Metropolitan Line. It is 10 minutes from Harrow-on-the-Hill Station.

### Coming by rail

Kenton Station is six minutes away. Some main line trains to Euston stop at either Watford Junction or Harrow and Wealdstone which connect with Kenton Station.

### Coming by bus

Buses 114, 140, 182, 183, 186, 201, 211, H14 pass the Campus.

### Coming by Car

From the M1 exit at Junction 4 and follow the signs for Harrow. From Central London use the A404 from Hanger Lane. From the West use the A40 to Greenford and take the A4127 North until you reach the Watford Rd then turn left. If approaching from the South then the entrance can only be reached by going around the roundabout. Once inside the University site please follow the one way signs past the entrance to the car park.

Please advise the organisers immediately if in any circumstances you are obliged to withdraw prior to the Congress. An administrative deduction of £5 will be made from any refund of entry fee.

All events are Swiss competitions, not knockouts. All Players play in all rounds. Any withdrawal must be advised to the controller.
