## **SECTIONS**

There are 3 sections, Under 12, Under 10 and Under 8.

You must have been younger than the section age on 31st August 2018. So, Under 12 means a Year 7 or younger and Under 10 means a Year 5 or younger, Under 8 means Year 3 or younger.

## **PARKING**

Fischer time control - 20 mins plus 10 seconds a move. A brief explanation for those not familiar with chess clocks will be given at the beginning of the competition.

Parents and friends are welcome to stay, but should note that only stewards and players will be allowed in the playing areas. We do not provide any supervision of children between rounds so you must stay to look after your own children or arrange for another adult to be responsible for your children.
