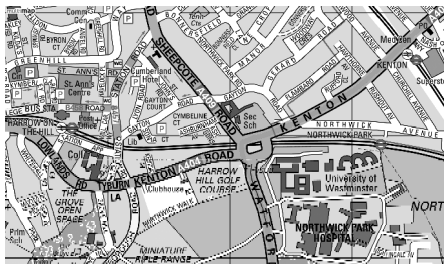

## Entry Details

**Qualification** is required for the Under 8, Under 10 and Under 12 Finals. See pages 5 & 6. Ages are calculated as at midnight 31st August 2009.

**A Late penalty fee** of £5 is due for entries postmarked after 7th December for the Under 10 and Under 14 events and after 15th December for the other events. Please note that entries sent in the week leading up to the event and posted second class may not arrive in time.

**Half Point Bye.** Any competitor may request a half point bye in any round except the last. Please make this clear on your entry form. The organisers would prefer all competitors to play in all rounds.

**Acknowledgement of entry** will only be sent if an SAE is enclosed with the entry or if a valid email address is supplied. If you wish to check on an entry please email [2009@ljcc.co.uk](mailto:2009@ljcc.co.uk).

The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entry. The Tournament Director has the final decision regarding eligibility to play in any event.

**Grading Information** It is a condition of entry that players agree to their grading information being published by the ECF. The ECF publish the Grading list on their website. If you wish to have your Grading details (Grading Reference Number, Name, Club(s), Grade(s), Grading Category) withheld from the website version please contact the ECF, <http://www.englishchess.org.uk>.

**ECF Members** are entitled to make a deduction (Game Fee) from entries posted before the late entry date. The amount depends on the event and is specified with the event details.

### Competition Rules

Clocks will be used on all boards in all events.

All events start at 9.45 a.m. each day.

All events are Swiss competitions, not knockouts. All players play in all rounds. Any withdrawal must be advised to the controller.

**Recording of Games** All games must be recorded, except in the Under 8 section. Players who do not have an accurate record at the end of the first time control will not receive the extra time for the game. A player will be required to make up any moves missing from their score sheet according to the ECF rules of chess.

**Late arrival** for any round. Contrary to FIDE rules players arriving after the re-pairing time of any round may be deemed to have lost by default, unless the controller can pair them satisfactorily. Players whose opponents have not arrived must expect to be re-paired.

**Re-pairing Times** Under 18/21 and Under 16: 30 minutes; Under 14 and Under 12: 20 minutes; Under 10 and Under 8: 15 minutes.

### Prizes

All advertised prizes are guaranteed.

Leading Girls or Leading Boys Cash Prizes will be awarded subject to a minimum of 4 girls / boys respectively or a score of 50%.

The London Girls' and London Boys' Championships.

Available in all events except the Under 21. Subject to a minimum score of 50%, the leading London players will be awarded the titles.

All trophies and titles will be awarded from the Major events.

**Eligibility.** Players born in, or who now live, work, or attend an educational establishment inside the M25 Motorway will be eligible for these prizes. Please say on the entry form if, you are eligible.

**SCCU Junior Prizes** Will be awarded to players associated with a county affiliated to the Southern Counties Chess Union. The prizes are awarded to the best boy and the best girl in the following events.

Under 9 best boy and girl in the Under 10 Major

Under 11 best boy and girl in the Under 12 Major

Under 14 best boy and girl in the Under 14 Major

Under 18 best boy and girl in the Under 21

**British Championship Qualifier.** The highest placed Under 21 not previously qualified who is eligible for the British Championship will be given an invitation to enter the 2010 Championships, to be held in Canterbury.

#### Discounts

These discounts only apply if the entry is postmarked before the late fee date for the specified event. A full entry fee and late fee are due for entries posted after this date.

**GMs and IMs** receive a free entry for the Under 18/21 event.

**FIDE rated players** 1800 or greater receive a discount of £3 for the Under 18/21 event.

**National Junior Squad members** receive a £3 reduction for one of the Under 12 Major, Under 14 Major or Under 16 events. Unrated Squad Players too old for the Under 16s may deduct £3 if entering the Under 18/21.

**Players playing in two events** may deduct £3 from the entry fee for the second event. This may be combined with another reduction listed above.

An Under 8 who qualifies for an Under 12 event may play in the applicable Under 12 event for the first day and then transfer to the Under 8 by paying the Under 12 entry fee and making this clear on the entry form. Entries on the day and players who have not paid in advance. All entry fees are due in full before the start of the last round of the first day.
