Which section should I enter?

Most juniors enter the age limit sections. These correspond to School Years, i.e. Under 8 is for Year 3 or below, Under 10 for Year 4 or 5, Under 12 for Year 6 or 7 You qualify for LJCC finals in Under 8 , Under 10 and Under 12 in respective sections.
