There are 3 sections - **Under 8**, **Under 10** and **Under 12**.

Each player will play 6 rounds and will be allowed 20 minutes and 10 seconds increment for each move per game. All games will be played with chess clocks.

Age is calculated as at midnight 31st August 2025.

Please note that this is not a knockout tournament. All players play in all rounds.

This is a qualifier for **London Junior Chess Championship 2025** to be held in December.

To qualify for the Final, players in the Under 10 and Under 12 Sections must score 3½ points to compete in the Minor and 4½ to compete in the Major. An Under 8 player can qualify by scoring 4 points.

Players in the Under 10 must have been born after 31 August 2015. This normally means Year 5 or below.

Players in the Under 12 must have been born after 31 August 2013. This normally means Year 7 or below.
