There are 4 sections - **Under 8**, **Under 10**, and **Under 12**.

Each player will play 6 rounds and will be allowed 20 minutes and 10 seconds increment for each move per game. All games will be played with chess clocks. Age is calculated as at midnight 31st August 2026.

Please note that this is not a knockout tournament. All players play in all rounds.

This is a qualifier for **London Junior Chess Championship 2026** to be held in December 2026.

To qualify for the Final, players in the Under 10 and Under 12 Sections must score 3½ points to compete in the Minor and 4½ to compete in the Major. An Under 8 player can qualify by scoring 4 points. LJCC under 10 & 14 on 12 & 13 December 2026 Under 8, Under 12 is on 28 to 30 December 2026

Players in the Under 8 must have been born after 31 August 2018. This normally means Year 3 or below.

Players in the Under 10 must have been born after 31 August 2016 This normally means Year 5 or below.

Players in the Under 12 must have been born after 31 August 2014. This normally means Year 7 or below.
