Under 8, 10 and 12 players not pre-qualified must obtain a minimum score in a qualifying tournament (see final page).

Ages are calculated as at midnight 31 August of the year of the finals.

Qualification information

For Under 8, Under 10 and Under 12 events:

Pre-qualification for Major sections is based on published ECF ratings (standard or rapidplay A or K, but not P rating)

Under 8 rating 1000 or higher

Under 10 rating 1500 or higher

Under 12 rating 1750 or higher

Qualifying scores based on six games

Under 8 4 points or more out of 6

Under 10 Minor 3.5 or 4 points out of 6

Under 10 Major 4.5 points or more out of 6

Under 12 Minor 3.5 or 4 points out of 6

Under 12 Major 4.5 points or more out of 6

Players who qualify for a Major section may not enter the Minor section.

Early bird discount. We offer an early bird discount which is £10 below the standard entry rate. Please check LJCC entry website for details on when early bird discounts end, and late fees start.

London prizes. To be eligible for a London title, competitors must currently live within the M25.

Half point bye. Any competitor may request a half point bye in any round except the last. Please email entry@ljcc.co.uk. The organisers would prefer all competitors to play in all rounds.

Rating information and privacy policy. It is a condition of entry that players agree to their rating information being published by the ECF, and to accept LJCC's privacy policy. Please refer to LJCC's privacy policy at www.ljcc.co.uk/GDPR

Withdrawal. Please advise the organisers immediately by emailing entry@ljcc.co.uk if in any circumstances you are obliged to withdraw prior to the congress. A deduction of £5 will be made from any refund of entry fee. PLEASE NOTE: we are unable to refund entry fees to players who withdraw within 24 hours of their event starting

The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entry. The Congress Manager has the final decision regarding eligibility to play in any event.

Clocks will be used on all boards in all events. All events start at 0945 each day. All events use the Swiss pairing system, not knockout. All players play in all rounds. Any withdrawal must be communicated to the controller of the section.

Recording of games. All games must be recorded, except in the Under 8 section. A player will be required to make up any moves missing from their score sheet according to the ECF rules of chess.

Refreshments. The LJCC Trustees hope that the canteen will be open for breakfast from 0900 each day. Normal canteen facilities will be available until 1600. Vending machines will also be available.

Parental responsibility. The organisers accept no responsibility for any loss, theft or accident during the tournament. Adult supervision will only be provided in the chess playing areas. Parents or guardians are responsible for their children during the tournament. The organisers and helpers are not able to act 'in loco parentis' and are not able to take responsibility for any child's actions, or for the actions of anyone that may affect your child. Players, their parents or guardians, as appropriate, agree to the terms and condition of their entry (errors and omissions excepted).
